



- No rain checks/refunds for any reasons, including weather
- Re-entry by wristband only (must be obtained at main entrance prior to exiting)
- In the case of inclement weather, water attractions will close for at least 30 minutes after the last occurrence of lightning or thunder
- Waterparks are subject to capacity. When capacity is reached, no more tickets will be sold and only people who have purchased admission tickets from the park for that day will be admitted. Waterpark officials have the right to adjust the capacity to meet the needs of the facility and maintain optimal safety
- For your safety, the following items are prohibited inside the waterpark: personal chairs, umbrellas, tents, grills, radios with speakers, balls, Frisbees and water toys

- Personal floatation devices must be **United States Coast Guard approved** with stamped seal
- Swim suit required for swimming
- Swim diapers required if children are not toilet trained, available for purchase at park
- Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult
- Service animals only will be admitted
- · Oakland County Parks and Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen property
- Persons with infections or communicable diseases or conditions such as a cold, the flu, or open sores are not allowed to enter
